By including Performance Space in your estate plans, you are helping us to ensure a creative legacy of experimental art that will continue to push boundaries for generations to come. Leaving a bequest to Performance Space is a testament to your love of the work that the organisation does, and to the importance of supporting artists at all stages of their creative development. We encourage you to discuss any estate plans with your family, friends and legal adviser. The following wording can assist in including Performance Space in your will. When discussing your gift, please consider giving us the freedom to direct your gift to the area of greatest need.

There are a number of ways in which you can leave a gift in support of our work:

- A percentage bequest
- A nominated percentage of your estate
- A specific bequest
- A specified dollar amount
- A residual bequest
- A specific balance or percentage of your estate after those specifically named in your Will have been provided for, and all debts and expenses of the estate have been paid.

As a guide, the following wording may be of assistance, though your solicitor will be able to offer more advice and assist you in preparing the document.

“I give and bequeath, free of all death, probate, estate, succession, capital transfer tax, capital gains tax and other duties [indicate percentage, amount or item] to THE PERFORMANCE SPACE LTD (ABN 97 002 898 866) with a preference that it be used for the [general purposes of the company/specify your preferred program]. I declare that the receipt of the secretary, treasurer or other proper officer of the nominated beneficiary will be a full discharge for my trustee who will not be bound to see its application.”
